Who are SAFE?

SAFE was founded in 2012 to rescue victims of trafficking in the UK. Since then we have been developing innovative ways to tackle child exploitation and trafficking. We work in a variety of sectors including hotels, children in care and education. We believe that the best way to end trafficking is to make it more difficult for traffickers. We have experience of working with survivors who were first exploited at a young age. That's why we work to empower and protect young people.



The Problem

- Estimated 35.8 million people trapped in slavery today. (Global Slavery Index 2014)
- Up to 13,000 in the UK. (Home Office)
- 85% of trafficked UK minors were sexually exploited in 2014. (National Crime Agency 2014)

Although slavery is illegal, slavery still exists today as a hidden crime. Often known as Human Trafficking, it is the commercial exploitation of humans, most commonly for the purpose of forced labour or commercial sexual exploitation.

Young people are highly vulnerable to this crime as shown in recent cases, such as Rotherham, Oxford and Rochdale. Thousands of young people are being targeted by traffickers who see their youth as a vulnerability to be exploited and manipulated for their own financial gain.

We work to empower young people so that they can protect themselves against those who would seek to exploit them through our Education Pack.

What is it?

Designed in partnership with teachers, safeguarding professionals and young people, the Education Pack helps young people to understand the ways that grooming can happen and the signs of exploitation and trafficking how to protect themselves.

- How to create awareness raising and fundraising campaigns

Impact

- Teachers have felt more confident to follow up safeguarding concerns after teaching the lessons.
- Teachers feel more confident to approach these topics with students.
